#### About e-Go aeroplanes

"The e-Go is a remarkably light single-seat aircraft. At the cutting edge of design & material innovation, it defines a new category of leisure aviation. We call it the **fun flying machine.**"

e-Go aeroplanes manufactures novel, composite, light aircraft which are fun-to-fly, smart, sophisticated, high-tech, and conform to the new UK Civil Aviation Authority category of de-regulated single-seat aircraft - flown easily by an average pilot with PPL or Microlight PPL.

e-Go was founded in 2007 with initial funding in 2011 from Marshall Aerospace, Hermann Hauser and local business angels to build a flying prototype, and with volunteers helping with computational fluid dynamics, finite element modelling, and materials & design choices.

Successfully first flown in October 2013, the e-Go combines interesting technologies: carbon-fibre composite construction, a modern rotary (Wankel) engine, integrated avionics systems, glass cockpit, and CANbus technology linking all the aircraft systems together.

It is now manufacturing the first customer aircraft, with delivery later this year.

Our visit will include a presentation by Adrian Hillcoat, CEO; a facilities and site tour; and a discussion/Q&A session with key team members.
